Campground General Information

- Propane and firewood are available for your convenience. Inquire at the office
- Convenience items are also available at the office
- Laundry room is on the south side of the office
- Bathrooms and showers are located on the north side of the office
- Recreation room has two pool tables, a jukebox and arcade games
- Outhouses have flush toilets and running water. Please do your part to help us keep them clean
- Water is potable. Bottled water is available in the store.
- Boat and trailer storage area is available for seasonal campers

Rules and Regulations:

- SPEED LIMIT IS 10 KM/ HOUR.
- Quiet time is 11:00 PM 8:00 AM
- No loud music.
- Day guests are to leave by 10:00 pm.
- Fires must be in approved fire pits and must be extinguished when not supervised.
- Respect other campers. Do not use other people's sites as pathways.
- You must be able to park your vehicles on your site. No parking on roadways.
- Visitors must register at the office.
- Visitors must park on your site or in designated parking areas.
- Alcoholic beverages must be consumed at personal sites.
- Please keep lots clean and garbage free
- Garbage bins are for household garbage only.
- Leaves, grass, clippings, branches, etc. can be put in the lawn and yard waste trailer. Please do not put food scraps, dog poop, or garbage in this trailer.
- Campers are responsible for disposing of barbeques, lawn mowers and appliances (DO NOT LEAVE BY THE DUMPSTERS).
- No cutting trees on campground property or within your site without permission.
- Changes in sites including decks, sheds, fences, trees, fire pits, etc must submit a plan to campground management for approval. Failure to do so could result in a fee. See seasonal guidelines for full details.

- Fire pits must have a 10' clearance from all combustibles.
- Campground management must approve any RV or trailer changes.
- No additional electric hot water tanks.

Quads and Golf Carts:

- Quads are permitted to drive in/out of the campground provided they are driven quietly and slowly in a direct route between 8:30 am-10:00 pm.
- All quads must be operated by someone 14 years or older (wearing helmets).
- Quads must be insured.
- Any guests bringing quads into the campground must register at the office. We will require a deposit. Please contact Willow Grove staff for more information.
- Golf carts must be driven by someone 14 years or older. An adult must accompany anyone between 12 and 13 years of age. Anyone under the age of 12 is not permitted to drive a golf cart.
- Golf carts are not permitted in playground areas.
- All golf carts operated after dark must have a proper headlight. Flashlights do not count.
- Electric golf carts are not permitted.

Pet Owners

- Aggressive dogs or dogs with aggressive behavior are not permitted
- All pets must be on a leash or otherwise confined at all times. Failure to do so will result in a fee of \$50.00.
- Do not allow your dogs to bark at or chase other campers. If you cannot prevent this we ask that you keep your dog inside. If you leave your dog inside when you leave please be sure it is not barking or disturbing neighbors. (check with your neighbor's).
- All pets must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Clean up after your pets. Failure to do so may result in a fee.
- No pets in the playground areas.

If rules are not followed you may be asked to leave the campground. Thank you for your cooperation.
